What is Home Care?

Home Care is non-medical caregiving services provided at home. The list of services and ways it can help is pretty exhaustive. If an adult or senior citizen needs help with routine, daily activities, then home care is the solution. Below are some common services that home care provides:

- Personal Care (bathing, dressing, etc.)
- Companion Care
- Dementia/Alzheimer's Care
- House Help
- Respite Care (Family Caregiver Relief)
- End-of-Life Care
- Transportation

Home care can provide as much or as little assistance as a family desires. Shifts can range from a few hours to 24 hours. Care Plans are custom-tailored to each client and their situation.



VA Benefit Programs

The VA has two different programs that can provide financial assistance for obtaining professional home care services.

	Community Provider Services	Aid & Attendance
Who is it for?	Veterans only	Veterans and/or Surviving Spouses
How to qualify?	Based on needs	Based on needs and income/assets
How does it work?	VA determines the number of hours of care the Veteran can receive at no-cost to them	VA determines the dollar amount for their monthly pension (cash payment)
How much can someone receive?	Hours can range from a few hours per week all the way to 168 hours per week (24-hour care)	Amount can range from \$1,432 to \$3,536 per month

*It is possible to qualify for one, none, or both of these programs.



Community Provider Services Eligibility



- Must not have been dishonorably discharged.
- Must be enrolled in the VA Healthcare system. (If not, must first join and be seen by a primary care provider.)
- Must have been a current or former member of the Reserves or National Guard who were called to active duty (other than for training only) by a federal order and completed the full period for which they were called or ordered to active duty. Duty requirements consist of:
 - Served 24 consecutive months or the full period for which they were called to active duty
 - Must not have been discharged for hardship or received an “early out”
- Other requirements may apply.

Aid & Attendance Eligibility

- Must not have been dishonorably discharged.
- Must have served at least 90 consecutive days during one of the following war periods: (Did not have to have been deployed)
 - WWII: 12/7/1941 - 12/31/1949
 - Korea: 6/27/1950 - 1/31/1955
 - Vietnam: 2/28/1961 - 8/5/1964 (must have served in the Republic of Vietnam for this time period)
 - Vietnam: 8/5/1964 - 5/7/1975
 - Gulf War: 8/2/1990 - TBD (must have served 2 years active duty)
- Assets less than \$150,538 (excludes home, car and up to 2 acres of land)
- If applying as a Surviving Spouse, marriage must have been valid during the time of death of eligible veteran
- One of the following health conditions must be met:
 - Needs assistance with daily activities (i.e. bathing, eating, dressing)
 - Bed-bound
 - Currently living in a nursing home
 - Eyesight is limited to a corrected 5/200 visual acuity or less in both eyes AND concentric contraction of the visual field is 5 degrees or less
- Other requirements may apply.

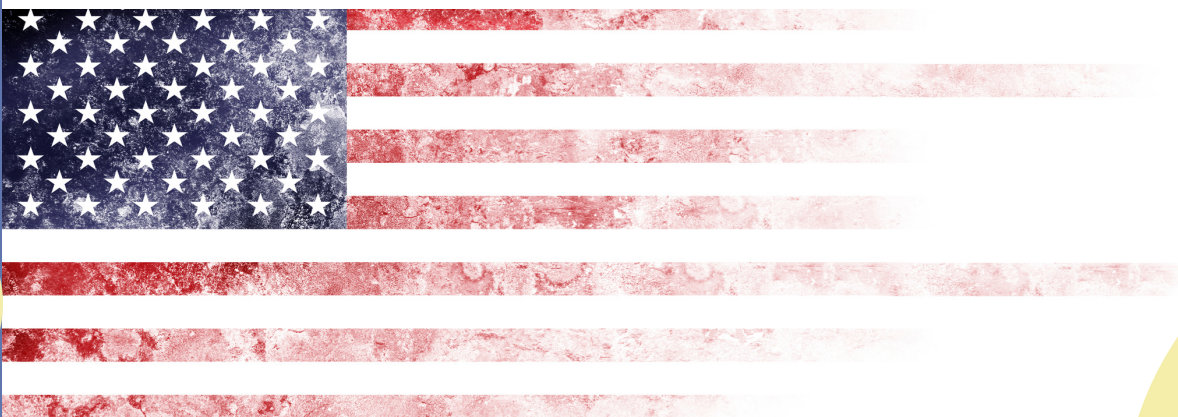
How to Apply

Community Provider Services

- If already established in the VA Healthcare system:
 - Contact your local VA point of contact (i.e.: case manager, social worker, primary care provider, etc.) to request a consultation for home care services.
- If not already established in the VA Healthcare system, you must complete VA Form 10-10EZ first.
 - VA Form 10-10EZ can be submitted by mail, phone, online, or in-person.
 - Feel free to call The Grandson Home Care at (254) 242-0772 for assistance with completing your VA Form 10-10EZ.

Aid & Attendance

- Must complete VA Form 21-2680.
- Call the VA at 1-800-827-1000 for more information and assistance.
